**TOPIC: February Minutes**

- **Minutes approved as written (by Maret Ryan)**

**TOPIC: Worship Council Announcement**

- **Jan Wagner gave background on meetings held by Lay Preaching Task Force**
- **Jan shared the Worship Council's recommendation to the Community Council that lay preaching continue through April as scheduled, when it will be discontinued in accordance with the Archbishop's wishes; with a focus on finding other outlets for lay preaching at Pax Christi if possible**
- **Father Kennedy expressed that parishioners are welcome to express their feelings on this issue to the Archbishop in their individual capacities**
- **The Justice Council expressed an interest in this issue and requested a meeting with a representative of the Task Force or Worship Council to understand more about how the recommendation was reached; Jan will request that Fred or Patricia Baumer meet with Justice Council**
- **All Council representatives voted to support the Task Force's recommendation with the exception of the Justice Council, which was heard on the issue**

**TOPIC: Leadership Retreat Follow-Up**

- **Meeting length issue: should Council meetings be changed to a longer period of time or should it be optional at the discretion of each Council?**
- **Consensus is to keep it optional at the discretion of each Council**
- **Interaction between Councils at group dinner: all appreciated the opportunity to sit and talk with members of other Councils and would like to continue**

**TOPIC: Renovation Committee**

- **Architect selection is complete; BWBR chosen from seven firms; creativity was primary criteria**
- **All Councils have meetings scheduled with architects in the coming week**

**TOPIC: Vision Discussion**

- **All Councils reviewed and discussed the new Mission and Values Statement at their meetings**

- **Each Council representative discussed the questions/concerns of their Council with the group**
- **Next step is presentation to the community in April (prior to the feasibility study)**
- **Another visioning session will be scheduled for after Easter**
