# 1. Introductions and picture taking

All council members introduced themselves to Fr. Bill. Members posed for the annual community council picture. Shannon attended the meeting and introduced herself to the council members.

# 2. Re-Engagement initiative goals

Phyllis gave a brief update to bring Fr. Bill up to speed on this objective. She also emphasized the need for each council to keep the theme of 'Belonging' in the forefront as we brainstorm new reengagement initiatives.



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Three councils presented their reports on their re-engagement initiatives.

- The Care and Support council presented its report on the ice-cream social/back-to-school drive. The council worked in collaboration with the Justice council and the Hospitality and Outreach council. Over 320 people served and 1663 items collected for back-to-school along with \$3000.00 in cash donations.
- The Arts, Campus and Gardens council reported on the following initiatives. Eagle scouts
  were involved in refurbishing the boardwalk around the pond at Pax Christi, new signage
  for rooms by small group of youth, and spring clean-up involving more than 60 people.
  There was discussion about recognizing and celebrating the efforts made by youth and
  about how to involve more volunteers on a consistent basis with the grounds and garden.
- The Hospitality and community outreach council reported on the walking activity on July 13 and 19, MN Saints game outing and support of the Back-to-school drive ice cream social.

### 3. Small group

A 6-member ad hoc committee is in the process of putting together a proposal for small groups for review by the Community Council. The plan is to start around Lent.

#### 4. Year with the St. John's bible

Carol Bishop handed out a working schedule/calendar of the activities planned for the St. John's Bible. Plans are in the works for production of a SJB calendar that will list primary events for the year with the bible.

#### 5. Homecoming weekend

Oct 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> will be celebrated as homecoming weekend. Various activities have been planned including an inter-generational show-up choir, special processional during all masses, hospitality following all masses with a special "Fiesta" themed hospitality after the Sunday 11 am mass from 12-2 pm.

# 6. Nursery

This is an urgent need for young parent ministries. A survey sent out to parents of young children got only 9 responses but steps are underway to reopen the nursery. A job description for the nursery position has been posted and has received one applicant so far. Carol will continue hiring efforts to open up the nursery for masses, special events and MOMS ROCK.

#### 7. Announcements

The Hospitality and Community Outreach council is organizing a half-day retreat on Nov 5<sup>th</sup> featuring Paul Bernabei and will focus on creating connections that foster belonging.
