
Venture Crew 370 Trip to Grand Canyon and Zion

The local Venture Crew 370 recently took a high adventure trip in June to the Grand Canyon National Park and Zion National Park, where they spent ten total days covering Utah, Arizona, and Nevada. After that they spent another four days in Zion National Park where the Venture Crew did day hikes in the Narrows for two days. The Narrows is a slot canyon carved out by the Virgin River. The last day in Zion was spent hiking to the top of Angels Landing, which is one of the highest points in Zion National Park. "This was definitely a lifetime opportunity that I'm glad I went on, it kept me on edge the entire time, I didn't know what I was getting myself into but now I feel I could do anything"- Stephanie Born.
