## **A NOTE FROM FR BILL MURTAUGH**

There are many stories and sayings of the Christian hermits from the fourth and fifthcentury Egypt that have a unique place in Christian tradition. They have been a source of inspiration to the Western monastic movement throughout its history and are considered by scholars to be one of the important groups of documents



among early Christian writings. Yet, they are not well known to many Christians. I am sharing some with you because they point to humility and a non-judgmental way of life.

• Abba Sisoes said, "Seek God, and not where God lives."

• Some old men came to see Abba Poeman, and said to him, "Tell us, when we see brothers dozing during common prayer, should we pinch them so they will stay awake?" The old man said to them, "Actually, if I saw a brother sleepy, I would put his head on my knees and let him rest."

• A brother who had sinned was expelled by the priest from the church. But Abba Bessarion stood up and went out with him, saying, "I too am a sinner."

 There were two old hermits who had lived together for many years, and they never quarreled. Now one of them said, "Let us try to quarrel once just like other people do." And the other replied, "I don't know how a quarrel happens." Then the first one said, "Look, I put a brick between us, and I say, 'This is mine,' and you say, 'No, it's mine,' and after that a quarrel begins." So they placed a brick between them and one of them said, "This is mine." And the other said, "No, it's mine." And he replied, "Indeed, it's all yours, so take it away with you!" And they went away unable to fight with each other.

 Abba Poeman said about Abba Pior that every single day he made a fresh beginning.
