# A NOTE FROM FR. MIKE BYRON

Dear Friends:

For the past two weekends we have been welcoming dozens of young people to the table of the Eucharist for the first time, and it has been a wonderful celebration. Many of these same children experienced their



first reconciliation/penance a few months ago. I wish that my memories of those sacraments were as happy. Some of us will remember when those rituals were anything but joyful, but were instead terrifying. I recall my "first confession" being in a dark enclosed closet, waiting for the priest to pull back the screen that would have been my cue to recite my transgressions to an anonymous voice. I wonder now what that was supposed to have accomplished. We had completely lost our way as church. Similarly, I received my "first holy communion" kneeling at a railing, with my pastor uttering Latin words to me that made no sense, and all I knew was that the correct response was "Amen," and that I'd better not mess up. Once more, the prevalent emotion was fear, not love.

Our church has exploited the human instinct of fear and coercion for far too long. This is not why Jesus came to live among us, and it's not why we choose to gather together in gratitude for God's grace. Sacraments are meant to console and encourage, not to highlight our failures and shortcomings. Wherever that happens, run away. Pope Francis has made it a habit to point out that our community is a bunch of pilgrims trying to do our best to follow the example of the Lord, sometimes with relative success and sometimes not. Unlike some previous propositions from popes and bishops, we are not here to distinguish ourselves from the rest of humanity by our evident virtue and sinlessness. As if we could. We are, rather, here to encourage one another to be the very best disciples that we can be, and to invite others into the same journey.

I always am grateful to the witness of first communicants in our gatherings. They surely have no idea how powerful their living testament is to the rest of us. They merely present themselves as children willing to entrust themselves to the love of God and to the acceptance of the Christian community. That is what every single one of us should be doing all the time. Let us allow them to be our teachers, as indeed they are. The children, as Jesus noted, are the ones who best help us along to the kingdom.
