Day 3 Prayer

O Most Blessed Virgin Mary of Guadalupe! Seeing you surrounded by light, I can only think how you are intimately united to the sun of the Divinity. There is nothing in your home that is splendor, that is not grace, that is not sanctity. I can only believe that you are immersed in the sea of the most exalted perfections and attributes, and that God always keeps you in His heart.
